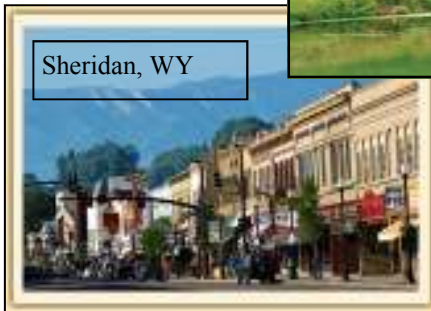

**How the Event is Organized**

There are 4 CEF chapters in Wyoming. Golfers from each of the chapters can organize their own team or be placed in a team. Each team will have 4 adult players. The teams will be handicapped against the other teams based on the ability of the team members. CEF teenagers will assist each team.

The goal of the event is to raise funds and awareness of CEF.



Proceeds from this event will go for a number of very worthy causes. Support for directors can make the difference between short term and long term missionaries and ministries. That support enables CEF workers to partner with local churches to establish Good News Clubs both in and out of elementary schools. It goes to provide high quality and effective teaching of children and training for local directors. It also enables CEF workers to partner with local churches for summer ministry in the form of 5-Day Clubs, Day Camps, Overnight Camps, and Fair Outreach. We also have a commitment to pay summer youth workers (Christian Youth in Action) minimum wages, and the State Office has made a commitment to pay College Age Interns an additional \$200 per month, a policy that is encouraging older youth to take leadership roles at an age in which their financial needs are growing.
